

There are many very nice Airbnbs, traditional B&Bs and more modern B&Bs, and hotels, all around the Chester and Hoole area. However, parking options at hotels are often limited and so you may have to find on-street parking or a car park. With Chester being a beautiful old, Roman city, it attracts many tourists, especially in the summer, and so this means that hotel prices are on the high side (you may find better deals on Airbnb; prices given below are for mid-August). Below are just a few that we can recommend as comfortable, but there are many others to choose from that you may prefer. **The Queen** (location: CH1 3AH): 4\* hotel, 4.2\* rated on Google. ~£80 p/n. Large, ornate hotel with many rooms, so could be a good one if you're coming in a group and want to book several rooms. Straight opposite the train station and so also convenient if you're coming by train. Limited parking. It's a 16 minute walk to Northgate Church and a bit less than that into Chester centre.

**Premier Inn Chester** (location: CH1 3AE): 3\* Hotel, 4.1\* on Google. ~£75 p/n. This is a typical Premier Inn – simple but clean, modern and comfortable, also with many rooms. No extras but does have en suite as standard and offers breakfast for an extra cost. Limited parking onsite (£10 per day if you get a spot). 14 mins walk to Northgate Church, 5mins walk to Chester Centre.

**Travelodge Chester Central Bridge** (location: CH1 1DF): 2\* Hotel, 4.2\* on Google. ~\$50 p/n. This is a simple but comfortable hotel within Chester centre. Car parking is available at a multi-story a few hundred yards away at a discounted rate through the hotel (£10 per day). 11mins walk to Northgate Church and this hotel is inside Chester centre.

**Mill Hotel & Spa** (location: CH1 3NF): 3\* Hotel, 4.3\* on Google. ~£100 p/n (includes breakfast). This is a modern hotel with lots of facilities (gym, pool, sauna etc), housed within a beautiful industrial building that used to be a Mill. 11mins walk to Northgate Church, 5 mins walk to Chester centre. Car parking is available and free if booked through the hotel (£12 per night otherwise).

**Moxy Chester** (location: CH3 5BS): 3\* Hotel, 4.2\* on Google. ~£80 p/n. This is a modern and comfortable hotel - the décor and style are definitely geared towards the young, hip (~student) kind of crowd, but there are a range of ages that stay here (so it doesn't feel like a youth hostel!). Has a small car park (extra £6 per day) so you may or may not get a spot. 17mins walk to Northgate Church, 10mins to Chester centre.

**Stone Villa Chester** (location: CH2 3NR). 5\* Hotel/B&B, 4.9\* on Google. ~£130 p/n (includes a very large breakfast). This is pricey but a good one if you want to have breakfast in – they offer a multi-course breakfast (fruit, yoghurt, cooked breakfast etc). They have a free car park. The staff are very friendly. There aren't many rooms and so if you want to book more than one room you'd need to book ASAP. This is a bit further out at 20mins walk to Northgate Church and Chester Centre. **There are also many less expensive B&B options within 5mins walk of this one.**

**DoubleTree by Hilton & Spa** (location: CH2 3PD). 4\* Hotel, 4.4\* on Google. ~£90 p/n (with current deal). This is an out-of-town option that's designed as a modern, Spa retreat kind of hotel (i.e. lots of leisure/relaxing facilities). Free parking available. 10 minute drive to Northgate Church and to Chester Centre (~45min walk).
